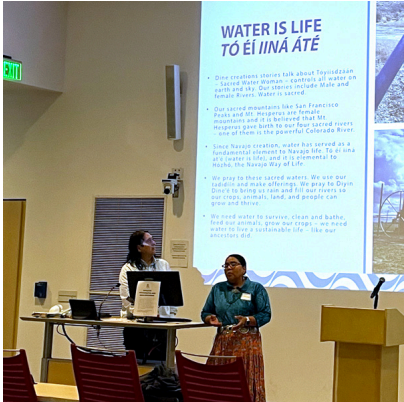

### Reflections: Groundwater at the Epicenter

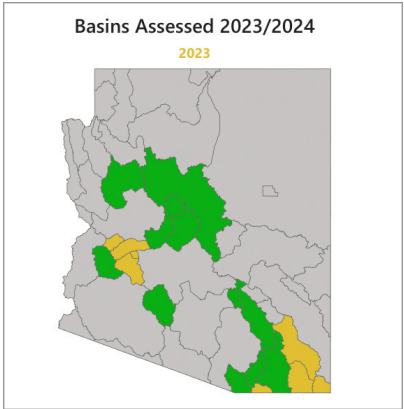
