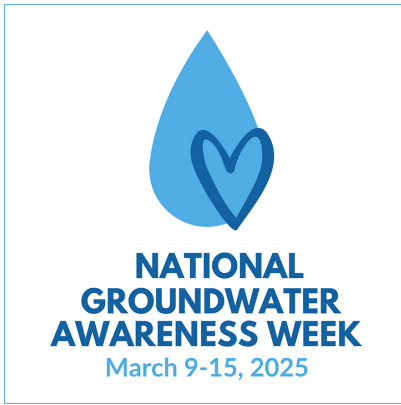


WRRC Residency Enriched My Transboundary Water Knowledge
