
WRRC 2020 Conference Poll Results






• What best identifies what we do/where we work?




2 Where do you see the greatest opportunity for improvement in water management?




3 Where are you most likely to go for information about water?

Geographically, what is your primary focus?







2 Do you believe Arizona is making adequate progress toward a resilient water future?




3 How often are you in contact about water issues with elected representatives at any governmental level?




4 Moving forward, how do you intend to help improve water resource management?
